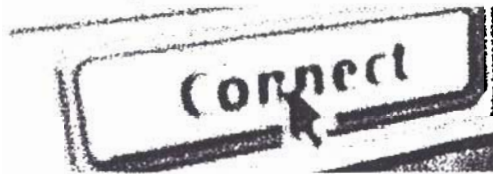


Biztranet relieves burden on busy accountants
